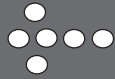

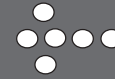

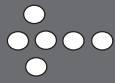

why do i need a brand new life?

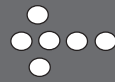

When they say life is a bed of roses, they are right! It can be beautiful and sweet, but for every petal, there is a prickly, painful thorn.

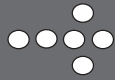
so what's the deal with a brand new life?



We're an optimistic bunch! We believe that life is not just a soap opera with some happy episodes and some tragic ones. Nope. We believe that there is a way to have life to the full, in spite of the obvious limitations of our human condition. And our hope is based on a promise made years ago.

The words go something like this, "**I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.**"

This is a tremendous claim! An ordinary person saying such a thing would probably be joking, or perhaps impossibly arrogant, or even mentally ill. But we take it seriously because we know that the man who left us these words keeps all his promises. **His name is Jesus.**

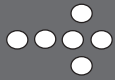


who is Jesus to you?

Some think he was a great sage, others consider him a prophet or a holy man. But the real question is **who YOU think he is.**

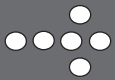


Jesus promises the Spirit

"And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always, the spirit of truth, which the world cannot accept, because it neither sees nor knows it. But you know it, because it remains with you, and will be in you."

John 14:16-17

Jesus promised his disciples to send the Spirit of God. On Pentecost, that Spirit came down upon them and **the lives of the disciples were radically transformed.** They preached the Gospel in boldness and power. Signs and wonders accompanied their words and they drew many to live as one in new communities.



do i need the spirit?

☑ In a word, YES!

- ☑ Before Jesus began His public ministry, he too received the Holy Spirit.
- ☑ Recall the conversation between Jesus and Nicodemus in John 3:5, "Amen, Amen, I say to you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and spirit."
- ☑ In Baptism and Confirmation, Catholics are sealed with the Holy Spirit. Yet few experience the radical Pentecost transformation of the apostles.

can i undergo that same transformation?



Of course you can!

"Ask, and it will be given you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For every one who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."
